## **IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM CONGRESS CHAIRMAN LLOYD MEREDITH** **15th Carbine Club International Congress - Adelaide - October 2022**



"The CARBINE CLUB INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS has become a very important event on the Clubs' Calendar since the first such event was staged in 1992. The onset of the Covid-19 pandemic has wreaked havoc on the plans for the 2020 Congress to be hosted by the Carbine Club of South Australia. Originally scheduled for May 2020, Covid forced a change in date to May 2022 which in turn was thwarted by international and interstate travel regulations. Given the commitment by the Australian Government at all levels to ease travel restrictions, the Congress has again been re-scheduled for October 6-11, 2022.
